In reference to application 2014/4197/P I would like to report the following:

As per the Council's website the decision for the application which also includes changes to the approved roof level glass balustrade has not been finalised. However, the applicant has proceeded with the installation of a fencing without obtaining an approval by the council (please see attached photos).

The installation of the fencing has now served as "real" evidence of what has been put forward in place of the original proposal.

The approved by the Council glass balustrade would serve as an elegant application and would offered the least visible obstruction between the historic Oakhill House and the adjacent new contemporary development.

The proposed alternative and already installed fencing is a rather inelegant metal barrier which even when covered by some planting cannot aesthetically compare with the original and approved proposal.

I would therefore like to bring to the Council's attention this issue for an urgent review to avoid a decision made on 2014/4197/P based on incorrect expectations and assumptions.




Photo 1: Installed Metal Barrier – Wide Shot
