

Georgian

Our Georgian bar windows are a highly economical option for creating any choice of bar configuration on casement windows. Like the Cottage windows, they can replicate any traditional window style and are ideal for period style properties and windows where you want to add additional features to a plain casement. There are two choices of Georgian bar. We can either place the bars between the two panes of the glazing unit – very easy for cleaning as there is no obstruction at all – or in addition to the internal bars we can also plant authentic looking bars on the external face of the casements. The choice is yours!



Cottage

Our Cottage windows are a leap forward in PVC-U window aesthetics. Cleverly designed glazing bars replicate all sorts of traditional casement window styles, down to the finest detail, like horizontal bar, all bar and cruciform bar, in fact any shape and configuration of bars you like. Firstly, we position glazing bars inside the glazing unit, then use authentic looking internal and external glazing bars on our white PVC-U windows, which makes each pane look individually glazed. Such is the attention to detail and the authentic look that has been created, these windows are perfect for traditional style properties or if you are wishing to add a 'country cottage' look to your home.



Flying Mullion

A mullion is the vertical member on to which the casements close. A flying mullion, however, is an integral part of one of the casements so that, when both casements are open, you have a clear and unimpeded view of the outside. When closed, it resembles a standard casement window and locks in place. Flying mullions on windows were first introduced as a means of fire escape and, although it can be used for aesthetic reasons, its principal purpose is still one of safety.
