Hedera (Ivy) instant screen 1.8m high Wire trellis between wodden posts set away from the wall of the bin store to prevent ivy suckering on to wall. Maintenance: Regular watering in first year until established, thereafter watering need will be minimal. Trim with hedge trimmer as required



Allium hollandicum Purple sensation: spring flowering, architectural bulb Maintenance: either cut back after flowering or leave seed heads to stand over winter.



evergreen mounded shrub, tolerant of pollution. Maintenance: Requires minimal pruning remove any misplaced branches



Festuca glauca Elijah Blue:
Grass - neat, rounded and
evergreen.
Maintenance: Comb through
plant in winter to remove dead
foliage. Replace plants every
few years when they become
tatty looking.
