I wish to add my views to those already on record supporting the **reinstatement, preservation and protection of the Castle Public House** at 147 Kentish Town Road. I join all the others in expecting the history of this building to be respected, as has been done by Camden Council by putting it on its list of HERITAGE BUILDINGS, while ensuring that Ringley honour the Public Order demand that it, Ringley, reinstate aspects of the Castle PH to its original features which Ringley, knowingly allowed to be destroyed. We, Kentish Town residents, want the architectural features replaced as demanded by Camden. We want this historic building to be used for its intended purpose as part of the cultural heritage of our area.
