I wish to object to the proposed roof extension at this address.

Over decades I have walked through this area of Bloomsbury and admired No 1 Colville Place, one of the few contemporary buildings whose quality is recognised by being listed; it combines modernist idiom with a sensitive relation to its neighbours, and maintains the structural unity of the terrace.

Surely any planning application which affects the terrace must take into account the proportions of the terrace as a whole, and protect the setting and context of listed buildings. This grossly disproportionate proposed roof extension would destroy the felicitous harmony of the terrace as it stands. Yours faithfully,
