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Your comments

My objections to this second planning application remain the same as I submitted in August, i.e. that felling this tree would cause my house and garden to be totally overlooked by the tall houses opposite on King Henry's Road, affecting my privacy. This tree greatly benefits the environment, giving off much-needed oxygen, thus helping mitigate the pollution and noise caused by increased flow of traffic on King Henry's Road.

I have noticed no deterioration in the appearance of this healthy-looking tree, seen from all levels of my house and from the pavements of King Henry's Road. Having lived here over 30 years, I have seen this tree flourish, and even if it has some fungus infection, it must have been present for a considerable amount of time as that is part of the natural environment which this beautiful hornbeam inhabits.

To all intents and purposes, this tree has put on a lot of growth and affords good shade in the summer.

I would agree to some severe pruning, carried out by specialist tree-surgeons as it has not been pruned for 3 years. I would object most strongly to its being cut down. I have always enjoyed and respected Camden's sympathetic attitude to the green environment we all appreciate, and greatly regret that, due to this winter's severe storms, we lost several mature trees in King Henry's Road.
