> 1. Clearly there is not enough information submitted by the > applicant for such a complex and massive construction proposal, equal > in size of footprint to the existing house, and questionably close to

> the foundations of this important Grade II listed building therefore > it would be impossible for Camden Planning to make an informed

> judgement from the information submitted by the applicant.

> 2. The elevation that has been submitted, number 0820/P/27 may at > first sight appear to be "existing", however, in this elevation there > is illustrated a two-storey extension to the north where currently > only a ground-floor bay window exists.

> I am not aware that the applicant has acquired planning permission for > a two-storey extension to the north.

> There are other discrepancies in elevation 0820/P/27: a chimney is > missing, raised skylights in the roof are missing, and this poses

> questions about the factual quality of this elevation and how accurate

> or not it is in representing the existing mass of the building.
