Objection to the Revised or Amended Plans for an Application for Proposed Works or Development  
in respect of a Parking Bay for The Hospital Club deliveries on Shorts Gardens

I am in receipt of your letter dated 8<sup>th</sup> September 2014 with a further circulation to Residents on the Shorts Gardens elevation dated 13<sup>th</sup> October 2014.

On behalf of Dudley Court Tenants' Association and the Residents on the Shorts Gardens elevation we are objecting to the above plans on the basis that Shorts Gardens is a narrow street and is totally unsuitable for the siting of such parking bay arrangements to be used to service deliveries and collections for The Hospital Club. Betterton Street is a wider street and more suitable for such a bay.

There is currently a petition being signed by the Shorts Garden's Residents which will be submitted separately as this will contain resident's signatures which have to be redacted for Data Protection purposes.

Shorts Gardens has been problematical in respect of heavy goods traffic for years and a petition was activated in 2011, signed by the majority of residents but not submitted as the parking bay proposals were shelved. I am attaching a copy of that earlier petition and also a photograph which illustrates exactly the problems and these problems are continuous day in, day out.
