The tree I would like to fell is the small conifer in the back rear of the garden. It does not have a TPO as far as I understand as we have existing planning permission to reduce the size of three other trees in the garden. I have contact an arborist about felling this tree and he has reported no issues with doing that work subject to the appropriate permission. The tree creates excess shading in the rear of the garden and low amenity value. Our intention is to erect a small garden shed in the back corner of the garden where this small conifer currently stands.
