Dear Mr. Oxford,

I should like to object to the application to remove the TPO so that this important lime tree can be felled.

The junction of Frognal Lane and Finchley Road is an area which is prone to flooding, and the trees here are important for soaking up excess water run-off. Lime trees are some of the best at filtering vehicle particulates and are much needed in this heavily polluted area.

The lime in the front garden of 3 Frognal forms an important contribution to the street scene. It is highly likely that other factors are implicated in the movement in the neighbour's property and this should naturally be investigated prior to taking any decision to potentially rescind the TPO.
