The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

The two storey studio and glazed link, by reason of their size, siting, bulk and mass, would detract from the garden setting of the host property, harm the character and appearance of the South Hampstead conservation area and harm the outlook of neighbouring occupiers contrary to policies CS1 (Distribution of Growth), CS5 (Managing the Impact of Growth and Development) and CS14 (Promoting High Quality Places and Conserving Our Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) and DP26 (Managing the



Impact of Development on Occupiers and Neighbours) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
