Charles Rose (CR) noted that sash window refurbishment may be considered acceptable if boxes are retained and new glazing is a laminated type.
CR noted that tanking to one vault would be acceptable if the other vault was retained in existing condition.
CR noted that an acceptable method of floor levelling was to install new intermediate floor joists between the existing.
CR noted that discretely adding 2 no. steel posts (50x100mm rectangular hollow sections) inside the shopfront to control further deflection of the timber bressumer should be acceptable subject to approval of structural engineer's drawings.
