Proposed removal of existing Sorbus aria 'Lutescens' (silver leafed whitebeam) located in front courtyard because of excessive shading and replacement by 1 No Amelanchier 'Robin Hill' 16-18cm Extra Heavy Standard 65L in same location.

The existing Sorbus was the subject of an earlier application reference 2014/2995/T following which a TPO was served (reference decision notice dated 6th May 2014).

The choice of 'Robin Hill' to replace the existing whitebeam was at the suggestion of the expert adviser on trees to the Regent's Park Conservation Area Advisory Committee following a site visit arranged by the agent in May 2014. With more delicate leaves and a much lighter canopy, it was felt that a 'Robin Hill' can continue to contribute to the character and visual amenity of the mews and provide an appropriate substitution and replacement for the existing silver leafed whitebeam.

The proposal was subsequently discussed in June 2014 with Mr Nick Bell, Tree and Landscape Officer LB Camden. Mr Bell suggested that an application might be submitted in autumn 2014 with a view to removal of the existing whitebeam and its replacement by an extra heavy standard Amelanchier during the November/March planting season 2014/15, subject to approval.
