INTRODUCTION

Countess Road is located in the residential area between Kentish Town and Tufnell park tube stations in the London Borough of Camden, The Street is made up of mainly three storey medium sized Victorian terraced houses built during the development of this area in the nineteenth century.

During the early 1960's many of the houses were bought by the local authority and converted into flats. No 4 being one of such properties was divided into a one bedroom flat - 4A on the ground floor with a two storey two bedroom maisonette - 4B on the 1st and 2nd floors.

4B was later sold to the tenant under the right to buy scheme. The current owners purchased the property in January 2011 from them. The place was ideal as it had a second bedroom to start a family and planning permission to extend into the loft and above the rear projection This later ran out and has recently been successfully reapplied for. Soon after renewing the planning however the flat below had a fire where the occupant died.
