



Dear Nick,

Further to our site meeting this week, regarding pruning of 6 no: trees to facilitate installation of a tower crane, please as urgent can permission be granted for the following trees as discussed.
The works are set to go ahead on Monday 17th November.

Prune the following property items:

- London Plane (427) (ID# 4) located at the Leigh Street end of Square
- London Plane (425) (ID# 5) located at the North Boundary
- Sycamore (423) (ID# 6) located at the North Boundary
- London Plane (450) (ID# 7) located at the Hastings Street end of Square
- Norway Maple (451) (ID# 8) located at the North Boundary
- Silver Maple (453) (ID# 9) located at the North Boundary

according to the following specifications:

- Reduce lateral spread over main highway by approximately 2-3 metres to provide clearance to mobile crane.

Remove resulting debris.

- All pruning works have been agreed with the local tree/planning (Nick Bell) officer on site.

It's been agreed that selected lateral branches growing over the highway will be pruned back to suitable growth points where possible, 1m beyond join line in road.
