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This estimate is to be read in conjunction with the visual assessment survey supplied .

1: Sycamore tree located on the south boundary.

Composted material has been built up by 800mm around the base of this old tree. The tree is the same age as the recent sycamore which fell. It is more than likely to have the same decay in the structural roots as both tree have had the same pruning .

Reduce crown by 4m

2: London Plane- Visually this tree looks in good health. Due to the size of the tree and its root position on the bank growing towards the sun on the south boundary, it would be prudent to keep the weight down.

Reduce crown by upto 2m

3: Leylandii- root plate has raised.

Height reduction required

4:Robinia- Leaning tree over the boundary wall.

Crown reduce by 2m to reduce risk of damage to the wall.

5:Eucalyptus- Growing close to the boundary. Routine pruning maintenance almost due.

7/6- Fire damaged trees. No immediate works required for safety.

Aesthetic works to remove the dead material.
