The Council has considered your application dated 11 August 2014 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

#### Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed works are considered not to be appropriate as the two trees contribute considerably to the amenity to the area. The evidence currently submitted to support the removal of the trees is not detailed enough to justify the trees removal. The council would consider a reduction to the crowns should an application be submitted.  
It is recommended that the application is refused to protect the visual amenity the trees provide and to preserve the character of the area.
