Proposal:  
(TPO REF: C682) REAR GARDEN: 1 x Tree of Heaven - Reduce crown by 30-35% to previous points. Thin and clean out crown and remove weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Reduce back by a further 1m approx. the large twin stem limb overhanging the first floor flats at No. 14. Lift canopy all round by 1 - 2m and balance crown.

The Council has considered your application dated 05 September 2014 and decided to grant consent subject to the following condition(s):

Conditions and Reasons:

- 1 This decision is valid for 2 years from the date of this decision or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.

Reason: To allow the Council to monitor the completion and standards of the work.
