Reason(s) for Refusal

The installation of the proposed rooflight, by reason of its large size and loss of historic fabric, would be detrimental to the special interest of the grade-II-listed building, contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework 2011.
