In addition, the car park, charity offices and hotel could all be located elsewhere, they do not need to be part of the hospital.</p> <p>It is not credible to propose a significant new building in the absence of a master plan for the already huge and ugly Royal Free site. Particularly before deciding on which site clinical and operational services are to be provided following the merger with Barnet and Chase Farm Hospitals (where, according to the Trust's newsletters, the 37 acre site has plenty of space). Services could be transferred to Barnet and Chase Farm freeing up space within the Royal Free itself for laboratory and research facilities.</p> <p>Finally, the plans totally underestimate patient parking requirements and will have an unacceptable impact on nearby roads.</p>
