I live at Number 38 Highgate West Hill and was not informed of a planning application at Number 40 Highgate West Hill although my property is in front/to the side of it and can see it clearly from my property. The date for comments has therefore expired but I was unaware of the application and I should have been notified.

The current use of health /surgeries is at odds with the rest of the properties surrounding it however I do envisage that converting this to a single dwelling will be difficult with the three 'studio' houses at 38a, 38b, and 38c alongside and neighbouring properties nearby. How will parking work? There is limited parking in the courtyard currently and there is limited parking on the streets. Will it have a garden/exclusive area to the front or will the courtyard continue to be shared? I am not objecting in principle but I envisage increased traffic and lack of space in the courtyard for such.
