The cracks to the building caused by the subsidence affect my flat and have an adverse effect on my quality of life a well as an economic impact on value of the flat and insurance costs have recently increased exponentially. The insurers also require us to act on recommendations in the tree report, which includes removal of the trees. If the trees are not removed, this exposes owners of flats at the build to the risk that insurance cover will not apply and, in turn, would lead to mortgage breaches and potentially serious consequences. A right to a home is a basic human right. As you will be aware, a application for removal was made approx. 5 years ago from recollection but the non-resident owner 34A Frognal objected - remedial were tried by inserting steel ties in the walls but did not work.	ng n
