Large, mature, pollarded tree. This tree has a large cavity forming at approx. 6m on the Northern side of the tree, where a stem was removed. This cavity is collecting water and this is streaming out lower down and staining the trunk. There is a large amount of weight sitting on this decay point. The suggested works are: To carry out a climbing inspection of the cavity, probe cavity to ascertain the depth and extent of decay, re-pollard to previous points to reduce mechanical loading
