This solid wooden door is original, dating to c 1889, To remove it would be an act of vandalism, which has already been notified to the Victorian Society. The present door has been satisfactorilly in place for the 40+ years I have lived here. If desired it could be refurbished and rehung. There is no argument for making it similar to other front doors in the block, which have glass in but are much more recent. To change the present door would disrupt the architectural integrity of the building, and would also pose a security risk in an area where drug trafficking and loitering in the early hours of the morning are on the increase, and would let in more noise on a road that is soon to see greatly increased traffic. This application has been lodged without consultation with the residents who live in this block, and does not represent the wishes of the majority. This application should be rejected.</p>
