I am writing to object most strongly to the proposed Royal Free/Hampstead Green development.

- 1) This is a massive overdevelopment of an essential green space that will be a blot on the landscape.
- 2) The districts of Hampstead and Belsize Park are, apart from the Royal Free itself, wholly residential areas with small pockets of shops to serve the residents. The proposed development is out of scale with the surrounding buildings and will be detrimental to residents' quality of life.
