I wish to strongly object to the proposed planning application for the establishment of a new private wing at the Royal Free Hospital. Apart from the emotional objection of a local employer of the scale and impact of the Royal Free making such little effort to properly consult the local community, as a resident on Constantine Road and someone who regularly walks along the path between the proposed developed the St Stephens I should know, I am appalled at the lack of consideration the proposed design has within its local context.

The scale, massing and visual impact is disproportionate to the sites setting. It will overwhelm St Stephens, negatively impact on the community and visual impact on the remaining green space and just builds on the carbuncle that the Royal Free is.
