I am writing to object to the above planning application by the Royal Free Charity. I strongly object to these proposed plans on the following basis:

The proposed size of the building will have a direct impact on the whole area which should be spared given its conservation status. The removal of green areas, including a hedge, path and mature trees should not be allowed in a conservation area.

The reduction of car parking spaces by a massive 43 would make the local untenable in terms of traffic congestion. It is already gridlocked at certain times of the day and this would only compound the problem. The Royal Free site is already significantly overdeveloped.

I find it deeply worrying that due to the position of the new building Hampstead Hill School (and especially its garden) will be severely overlooked by members of the public and staff.

Such a development would cause unacceptable disturbance for everyone but especially the school.
