Dear Mr Thuaire,

I would like to share my views on the above application as I believe you are the person dealing with it.

I think it is a shame that more has not been done to inform the public about this. I understand there are models in the hospital but for such a large scale development on public land I would think it appropriate to make sure those in the area and using facilities in the area be given more thorough information and on a more timely basis. I heard about this by chance and I believe have only just made the deadline for comments.

I find the wild, grassland area of Hampstead green, with trees and flowers a great relief from the traffic and built up area. To build on it and then crowd out the last remaining green space with an enormous development will in my view have a detriment impact on the area. It seems to me that a great deal has been done to preserve St Stephens and the height of this development will tower over it and the neighbouring school, blocking out light and congesting the currently open and pretty area. In my view it is too high and too bulky and should be reconsidered.

I am not against the construction of a new facility that will no doubt lead to a great deal of common good, but I think the consultation has been lacking and I have a fundamental problem with the size and the scale of the proposal.
