The right hand courtyard (looking from the hotel) air con unit

Remove the old fence and dispose off site

Reposition any plants that need moving

Around the new air con unit site construct two trellis fences (one at 3.2m and the other at 3.7m) of 1.8m high wide gapped trellis or Picardy lattice (as seen below, first and second pictures), using 3 by 3 inch posts and bolted down post holders. Painted evergreen to match planting as approved by council in application.





Plant around the above 6.9m long trellis fence,10 evergreen shade tolerable ivy's (each one about 1.5m high with spread of around 50cm) using quality compost and drainage shingle

Each plant to be planted in a planter (approx. 40cm high) – there are hundreds to choose from but here are some that we think will fit in the best (with the last being a very good choice as you already have these planters on site)



Cost = £1635 + VAT

The above cost is for the wide gapped trellis and for us using the forth planter above If you would like the second type of trellis then the cost would be $\pounds 148 + VAT$ more

The left hand courtyard air con unit

As above, but have one trellis fence from one end of the court yard to the next (6.3m in all), however the patio is not strong enough to support the 'bolt downs' so sections of the patio will have to be removed (this may have been done by the builders already so this quote assumes that a 50cm wide patch of soil will be left for us to put our fence posts into)

Dig down foundation holes of two foot and set central posts in concrete

Build the 1.8m high wide gapped trellis or Picardy lattice trellis using the central posts and posts frame fixed to exterior walls

Plant in front of the above 6.3m trellis fence, 10 evergreen Jasmines (each one about 1.5m high with a spread of 60cm) see below picture, in pots as above

OR

In a bed of soil if one can be left by the builders



Cost = \pounds 1439 + VAT for the plants to be planted in pots Or \pounds 1039 + VAT if the plants (which will be 40cm taller) could be planted in the soil

The above prices are for the wide gapped trellis, if you would like the second type of trellis then the cost would be \pounds 148 + VAT more

If you would like more or less plants please let us know.

Reasons for Jasmine and ivy:

It will cover the entire trellis in years to come Its evergreen Its easy to maintain The Jasmine already growing in the left hand court yard The ivy will be ok in the shade

If you wanted larger or more plants to start off with so that more of the trellis is covered please let us know
