Dear Sir/Madam

I wish to lodge objections to the above Planning Application.

My wife and I own and occupy 170a, Haverstock Hill NW3 2AT, the Garden Flat of 170 Haverstock Hill. Our flat is below pavement level.

Our property shares a party wall with 168 Haverstock Hill, the building of the proposed development.

We have several reasons for objection:

- 168 and 170 Haverstock Hill are a pair of Georgian buildings and therefore of considerable age. They share a party wall and we are very worried indeed about the possibility of damage to our own building and very specifically to our own flat. The property is on a hill and it seems to us possible that the slope might be subject to land instability if a basement is constructed immediately adjacent and downhill from our property
- 2 Haverstock Hill is a road of quite high traffic density and it seems to us possible that heavy goods vehicle movement with attendant vibration might well contribute to the risk of instability.
