					My primary concern is regarding the submitted drawings. I feel they are lacking in detail and dimensions and it is therefore impossible to tell how high the mansard roof will be in relation to the adjoining mansard at 5 King's Terrace.
					I would also suggest that the mansard plan as submitted is for a conversion that is not in keeping with the style of mansards that have already been added to the southern end of King's Terrace (nos 2, 4 and 5). A mansard design with sash windows rather than Velux windows would be much more in keeping with the area.
					I would also ask the council to consider applying an S106 legal agreement to this development which specifically requires a construction management plan that covers the delivery of materials and removal of rubbish from site. I ask this because the southern end of King's Terrace is a dead end mews to which several residents and businesses will require uninterrupted vehicle access. Given that the mews has recently been resurfaced I would also ask the planning department to consider applying a highways contribution as part of any S106 legal agreement to cover the cost of any repairs that may be necessary following the completion of the works.
