I write as the Landlord of Flats 1-4 at 109 Canfield Gardens, London NW6 3DY and have confirmed today from my visit to the ground floor flat at 109 Canfield Gardens that this plan would indeed reduce the enjoyment to be had from the neighbouring properties.
