Nice to meet you today. Thanks for coming and advising us.

As we discussed we will leave the Robinia tree in place, as you have instructed, but would like to undertake the following work:

- Carefully remove the soil/rubble around the base of the tree to find the true ground level. If anything this should assist the tree
- Raise the crown to reduce the weight of the canopy and to let more light in under the tree. I would like to remove the two lower branches and a third one a little higher up that is projecting forward into the garden.

I attach a photo that should give you some idea of this.

I would also like to remove the willow tree that is planted in the lawn very close to the house. This tree will get very large in time and is inappropriate for this position beside the house. Again I attach a photo of this tree. On your visit you indicated that this should be acceptable.
