I am writing following our pre-commencement meeting on the 17 December 2014 at the above site. During that visit, we met with Mr Gamble (Project Manager, M Design) and Mr Pearse (Construction Manager, Knightbuild). We inspected the tree protection measures installed on site and referred to the Barrell Tree Consultancy arboricultural impact appraisal and method statement report dated 20 January 2012, our reference 10159-AIA3-AS, and plan BT5.

From our inspection, we agreed that all the tree protective measures are in place as set out on plan BT5. During my visit, I took photographs as a permanent record of the site conditions and include a selection below.
