Proposal:

Retention of 2 x lamppost and 3 glazed windbreaks mounted on 6 metal posts to forecourt of restaurant (Class A3).

The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

## Reason(s) for Refusal

- 1 The proposed glazed windbreaks mounted on metal posts, by reason of their siting, design number, material and fixed nature would result in visual clutter harming the character and appearance of the host building and the wider streetscene contrary to policies CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
- 2 The proposed fixed lamp posts, by reason of their siting, height and design would



appear as over-dominant structures resulting in visual clutter harming the character and appearance of the host building and the wider streetscene contrary to policies CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policy DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

## 1 ENFORCEMENT ACTION TO BE TAKEN

The Director of Culture and Environment will instruct the Head of Legal Services to issue an Enforcement Notice alleging a breach of planning control.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
