Thank you for your consultation dated 20 October 2014.

The Greater London Archaeological Advisory Service (GLAAS) provides archaeological advice to boroughs in accordance with the National Planning Policy Framework and GLAAS Charter.

Having considered the proposals with reference to information held in the Greater London Historic Environment Record and/or made available in connection with this application, I conclude that the proposal is unlikely to have a significant effect on heritage assets of archaeological interest.

Although the proposed development site lies close to the Hampstead Archaeological Priority Area on present evidence it is unlikely to have an effect on



heritage assets of archaeological interest.

No further assessment or conditions are therefore necessary.
