I live at 6 Orde Hall Street, Flat D, and my sons own Flat C at the same address. This property constitutes the end wall of the garden of 20 Dombey Street.

There is a creeper that goes up the wall of 6 Orde Hall Street, and the back wall of 4 Orde Hall st., growing from this garden. Both creepers have been causing damage to the properties for many years. The creeper has in the past grown all over the roofs and this has caused considerable problems for tenants and for Camden as they have had to pursue the owners of 20 Dombey St to get the creeper cut back. It has also grown over the outlets for the central heating at No.4 which is positively dangerous.

Therefore this is an opportunity once and for all to destroy the creeper completely. Please therefore extend the work to include this.
