2014/6594/P	Hunada Nouss	7 Back Lane	22/12/2014 14:26:55	COMMNT	<p>Further to my conversation with Katrine Dean this morning, I am writing with my comments and concerns on the proposed erection of dormer windows at 5A Back Lane.</p> <p>I live at 7 Back Lane the property that is adjacent to 5A Back Lane, but more importantly sits in front of it, such that the back windows of my house, and my patio garden look out on the wall and roof of 5A Back Lane.</p> <p>It is difficult to assess from the drawings whether the back of my house looks onto the front or back elevation of 5A Back Lane. I understand you have not visited the property and cannot advise me on this.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the front elevation, the proposed changes add two new windows to the left hand side of the roof, above existing windows, and that does not give me any concern.</li> <li>•</li> <li>• If the back elevation, the proposal envisages 5 sets of dormer windows being erected along the length of the roof. In my view, this would represent an unreasonable impact on my privacy and I strongly object to the proposal. The current roof has only velux windows, which assures me privacy as the bedroom and bathrooms that sit at the back of the house and the patio garden are not overlooked. The garden is very small: it is just 5 metres from the back wall of my house and the wall of 5A, and possibly 8 metres from the windows at the height of the roof, allowing any onlooker to look straight into my bedroom and bathroom. I trust you agree that any such intrusion on privacy is unreasonable, given how close the two buildings are.</li> </ul> <p>Thanks you for taking my comments and concerns into consideration.</p>

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
