> I am very concerned about this application and wish to object. I have lived in number 10 for 45 years and have observed all manner of alterations and works on the Terrace. From those many reference points and associated conversations the danger of movement in the houses has been a constant concern. My experience is that movement does happen whenever the ground is disrupted, leading to cracking and other associated problems. An expert I consulted explained that this was due not just to the slope and soil but also the architecture at the time, which involved inadequate foundations by modern standards. All of these factors and my long experience here makes me deeply concerned.
