There are other markets of this type in Hatton Garden and by the sheer quantity of traders in such a confined space causes a considerable amount of people to congregate around the pavement area, some even handing out leaflets and generally approaching members of the public, trying to entice them inside. Many members of the public find this to be quite intimidating and it will discourage them from visiting Hatton Garden.</p> <p>Blocking the pavement with these additional people milling around will not enhance the area and if this indoor market is to open, it should have a space outside the unit but within its boundary for people, if they wish, to congregate. By moving the glass front/door line to the pavement edge is, in my opinion, totally unacceptable and this application should be rejected by the local authority.</p>
