Also, the appearance is out of character with a listed building and does not conform to the neighbouring properties.

We received notification of the planning application from LBC by letter dated 11.12.14.  We wish to object to the application for planning permission. The grounds of our objections are that (1) the development (which for the avoidance of doubt is two separate structures - one a rear addition attached to the main house; the second a separate detached residential unit in the rear of the garden of the property) involves a substantial intrusion into a lovely green space created by all the gardens of Mornington Terrace and Albert Street ("the green space")  (2) the development will bring light and noise pollution into the green space, as any use of the detached building will result in light being cast over the green area after dark, the rear addition comprises glass over most of its surface area, and it can be expected that the development will be used for entertainment purposes among others, resulting in increased noise pollution  (3) the development will set a planning precedent for living rooms or granny flats being created in the green space, which at present is not developed in that way, and which would be detrimental to the amenity of all the houses and flats backing onto the green area  (4) the design of the rear addition is intrusive and out of character with the listed buildings in this areawe have photographs showing the previous rear addition and the new rear addition from the rear of our house.
