					Altering properties to the point where they bear no relationship to their original size does not seem correct for a listed building within a conservation area.
					We are also concerned about the future stability of the main buildings as the excavation works that were done to No 2 St. George's Terrace several years ago clearly had a detrimental effect on several of the neighbouring houses which suffered extensive cracking to walls, clearly indicating that there had been movement/settlement caused by the works.
					It is interesting to note that other London Councils have now banned similar developments; Kensington and Chelsea and Islington are both examples.
					The proposed loss of garden space with the correct planting depth for bushes and trees is also most regrettable.
