117 Arlington Road, London – Design and Access & Heritage Statement

This report relates to the planning application to replace one window in the basement well at the front of the House. The work consists of replacing a very ill fitting, non original metal window with a new single glazed wooden casement window.

Character and Architectural / Historical Interest

The application site is located on the West side of Arlington Road, approximately two thirds along the stretch between Parkway and Delancey Street. The house is in the Camden Town conservation area.

Number 117 is part of a terrace of 23 houses. Built in the 1840s. The houses are constructed using stock brick with render to the ground floor and basement. Slate roof with party wall stacks. The houses are 2 windows wide with door to right, three storeys and basement. All windows with small-pane glazing bar sashes, the upper floors set in moulded architrave surrounds and the ground floor round arched with margin-lights.

This application relates to 1 window on the front elevation at basement level.





Scope of works

The Labelled Elevation photographs show the window to be replaced.

The schedules of work drawings overleaf detail the work carried out.

In summary it involves replacing a non original metal casement window with a new non opening casement window. The casement will be split into three equal sections. It will be painted white and will be single glazed.

The schedule of work also shows that we will be fitting new draught strips to a small rear window (Item 2).
