NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x False Acacia (larger) - Reduce & reshape crown by up to 2m by thinning branch ends by 25-30%. Thin and clean out and remove weak and suppressed branches and suckers. Lift canopy by 2m

1 x False Acacia (smaller) - Reduce & reshape by 20-25%, thin and clean out crown, lift canopy by 2m

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Silver Birch - Thin crown by 15-20%, prune back from building by 0.5-1m, balance crown

1 x Sycamore - Repollard to main trunk knuckles

1 x Lime - Reduce crown by 30-35% (to previous points), lift canopy by 1-2m

2 x Lime - Reduce & reshape crown by 20-25%

1 x Purple Leaf Plum - Fell to ground

1 x Fig - Lift and balance crown by up to 1m

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 26 September 2014 and does not wish to object.

- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
