This tree is lopsided and needs rebalancing. It is pushing the wall over and shading the garden. It has been compromised by the Wisteria which is now dead.

Ash (T2): Remove x 2 Secondary Stems and Reduce by 30% - up to 2.5m off Height and Width.

This tree is leaning due to x 2 Stems which are believed to be another tree which has merged with the larger Ash. It is blocking light to the property and it is too close to the boundary wall - it will cause damage if it is not contained
