I am writing to object to the plans for La Swap Sixth Form building along Highgate Road NW5

We came to live here in 1970. The greens extended from Glenhurst Avenue and Lissenden Gardens. Then Parliament Hill School applied for permission to tarmac over the adjoining area of greenery to make a car park in the school grounds, with the promise of replacing the trees which were cut down. Needless to say, the trees were not replaced *adequately*.

Now it is proposed to cut down more trees further along from the car park in order to put up the one storey La Swap building – this will no doubt prove to be inadequate in a few years time and the precedent having been created, no doubt further storeys will be added thus completely altering the approach along Highgate Road to Hampstead Heath.

This green streetscape has been radically altered over the last forty five years and the La Swap building if built along the Highgate Road will further erode the character of this area.
