Request for scoping opinion under the Town and Country Planning (EIA) Regulations for the residential development at the former reservoir site, Gondar Gardens, as set out in the EIA scoping report prepared by Peter Randmall Associates.

Thank you for consulting us on this EIA scoping opinion. Having reviewed the report prepared by Peter Randmall Associates we have the following comments to make.

We agree that Flood Risk and Drainage should be included as a chapter (Table in section 5.1). This chapter of the EIA should demonstrate that surface water will be discharged from the site at greenfield run-off rate through the use of Sustainable Drainage Techniques (SuDS).

The Scoping report makes reference to the requirements of the NPPF but this chapter should also comply with London Plan Policies '5.13 Sustainable Drainage' and 5.11 'Green Roofs and development site environs' of the London Plan.

We also recommend that this chapter of the EIA is informed by and compliant with the recommendations of your Strategic Flood Risk Assessment, Surface Water Management Plan and Local Flood Risk Management Strategy.
