1 Reason for granting permission:

The submitted information confirms that chartered structural engineers have been appointed to oversee the basement construction works. The engineers have the relevant C.Eng, MIStructE, & M.B.Eng qualifications which comply with the requirements of Camden Planning Guidance (CPG4 - Basements and lightwells). The details submitted are considered to be sufficient to satisfy the requirements of condition 4 of planning permission 2014/5832/P dated 14/11/14.
