There are three mature, established trees in the rear garden of 12 Maryon Mews, not two as on the drawing. Does this mean that the intention is to cut down one, even though the Application Form says that no trees will need to be removed? Also, if this detail is wrong on the drawings, how can we be sure that all other details are correct? If the tree is to be cut down, I object on this ground, and also on the grounds of inaccurate plans and an inaccurate application.</p> <p>2 The proposed additional window on the first floor, and the window to be installed in the extension to the first floor (Elevations 4 & 5), will both overlook properties at the rear. This will interfere with privacy of adjacent properties. I object on this ground.</p> <p>3 Ground Floor Plan Ex & Pr A1000 shows changes to the rear garden that are not mentioned in the proposal. The existing plan shows a line inside the boundary walls and passing between the two trees and the house. This has disappeared on the proposed plan. If this is a wall or something similar, removal may have implications for the drainage or structural integrity of the adjacent structures. I object on the grounds that this proposed change is not detailed and that its consequences are uncertain.</p> <p>4 Please inform me of the committee date.</p>
