I am writing to lodge objections to the application for the West Hampstead Railway Station in West End Lane.


Whilst accepting that the station needs to be enlarged due to increased passenger usage, I don't consider that the replacement design is of sufficient high quality and fully agree with other objectors that it gives a petrol station frontage impression.

In addition, the flat roof adds nothing to the design and this design needs to be improved. If at all possible, it would be desirable to incorporate the present brick façade into any enlargement plans in order to preserve the present street scene.

The present façade blends well into the current surroundings and some further imaginative innovation seems called for.

I would therefore also urge that this application be submitted to the committee for these reasons, as the present design is not of sufficient high quality for this important transport interchange site and not determined under delegated powers.
